Usually our days are pretty full with taking care of dogs and cats on the island but every so often we are asked to help with more exotic animals.

Our special protégé Ling, the monkey, needed our help again. After taking care of him a few months ago, we've checked Ling regularly and we faced a certain problem with his injury: How to get close enough to give him the injection?? First of all, our helper Jaa broke the lock open, as we had the intention to catch Ling with a rope. Then we pulled Ling's arm through the wire fence so that we would be able to give him the antibiotics shot. After 3 treatments he was okay again, but at the third "turn", it wasn't that easy to place the injection: monkeys are quick learners!

Shortly after his recovery "smart" tourists had broken open his cage and set him free. His owner was lucky enough to soon get hold of him again: he would have died of starvation; Ling has been living in a cage for so many years, he had never learned to care for himself and what should he eat on the beach?
