Unfortunately, until now we have found only the dog MAXIME at the Pinnacle Resort, Maenam. The general manager of Imperial Boathouse Doeke Bonga has explained Michael Theiß (a guest from the Boathouse) that he has received orders to remove the dogs from the beach at the Boathouse in Choeng Mon.

We have printed reward papers and walked down the beach from Pinnacle far beyond the Manaem temple. We have spoken to the manager of the Pinnacle Resort. He is very co-operative and wants to inform us when Max shows up or if he has problems with dogs on the beach. There will always be dogs on the beach of the Pinnacle because the temple is not far away and is also right on the beach. Some tourists are living there only because of the dogs and are always looking forward to meeting their favourite pet again when returning to Samui.

We suppose that MAX and MAXIME have been abandoned at the temple in Maenam. What will become of Maxime? She is now in our shelter. Must she remain there for the rest of her lifetime? She has lived with Max on the beach at the Boathouse for almost 10 happy years. They are the darling pets of many regulars of the Boathouse.
