Our non-profit status is checked here in Thailand every year.

This check, with all donation receipts, bank statements, expenses, etc., takes about 3 months each time.

We have achieved this goal again this year and can claim

the title of the only official non-profit foundation with a Thai license on Koh Samui.

As every year, we are very happy about it!

It is great for our dogs and cats that many visitors from the island, but also from all over the world, find their way back to us.

Tourists, guests, long-time supporters and many friends come almost every day

to give our four-legged friends a cuddle and a cuddle.

We are very happy to receive donations in kind, such as **food and collars, as well as tools, building materials, etc. and financial support** so that we can pay for medicine, wages, food, etc.!

We are also very happy to receive (old) towels.

So if you have a few kilos left on your trip to Samui, please fill your suitcase with them!!!

Visitors are welcome every day!

We are here 7 days a week and are happy about everyone who finds their way to us in Chaweng and also in Ban Taling Ngam.

In our cathouse in Ban Taling Ngam we have a **big fish party every day** for more than 100 cats.

We buy fresh fish at the market and then cook it for our furry friends!

They also get **vitamins, other proteins and medicine** if they suspect they have cat flu, which is unfortunately extremely common on Samui and almost no cat is spared from it.

We also need a **few more cat houses** so that we can separate them better if necessary.

A house costs around €50

We also want to build a **new, large cat house in Chaweng for around 20 - 30 furry friends!**

The estimated cost is around €1200





We are always in need of **flight sponsors** to bring our darlings to their new owners overseas.

Please contact us, also to **bring serum for the blood test!**

Many darlings were able to fly overseas to their new homes.

We are delighted that so many dogs and cats from and in Germany, Switzerland, Austria, France, Spain, but also the USA and UK have found a new home.

Many thanks again to **Christine and Detlef**, who are doing such a wonderful job in Bangkok to get the dogs and cats ready to leave!

We have been **supporting the temples** on Koh Samui for many years with food for their dogs and cats as well as with sterilizations, medical care, etc.

We would like to $\boldsymbol{\text{thank}}$ the $\boldsymbol{\text{monks}}$ for their cooperation.

Our president Khun Wit is of course still leading the temple project and is in contact with the monks, s o that we can react quickly even in emergencies

There are many emergencies all over the island where we are called and respond immediately!







Thanks again to the many visitors who support us here on site with food, medication and financially, etc.

Without them, the survival of the Foundation would hardly be possible!

We absolutely need products like **Simparica**, **Nexgard Spectra and Bravecto** against the many parasites, such as ticks, fleas and mites (mange) for our projects outside, but also in the animal shelter! **One pack costs about 35 euros** and we can treat an average of 9 dogs with it!

We help everywhere on the island with food and medical care!

Fortunately, we also have volunteers who drive around the island to feed and look after their pets.

We will continue to **help on the mainland in the future**, as I believe that our commitment to animal welfare does not have to end at the borders of Samui!

Here again the note that friends and supporters have **founded a new, second non-profit organization in Germany!** We currently do not charge any account management fees on this account!
