


Many animal-loving visitors from all over the world found their way to us again to help and support us!

Thank you to all adopters, flight sponsors, and everyone who helps ensure that these beloved pets can travel to their new homes.






































An indispensable pillar of our foundation has become our volunteer program, led by Hasse from the Netherlands and Dr. David from Spain!
























## Many unbelievable cases, unfortunately, also involve animal abusers.

Many thanks to the **Swiss association** and their friends for their wonderful support over the years, the generous donations , and the lovely visits to both animal shelters!













Thank you so much for the wonderful donations: Souvenirs, towels, toys, medication, food, leashes, collars, money, etc.























We're always in need of **flight sponsors** to bring our beloved pets overseas to their new owners.

Many thanks also to Penny and Ralf from Lamai, who always help us with feeding at the old pier in Ban Kao! We're also trying to help more and more on the mainland.









One pack costs about 35 euros, and we can treat an average of nine dogs with it!
